- Action Orchestrator 5.1.3 and later:
 - Is only supported on [CloudCenter Suite 5.1](#) and later installations.
 - Can be upgraded to or installed on any CloudCenter Suite system as long as the system uses [CloudCenter Suite 5.1](#) or later versions.

- Due to planned deprecation of Python 2.7.x, the Execute Python Script Activity for Python 2.7 (Obsolete) will be deprecated in the following release.
 - Previous workflows using the noted Execute Python Script Activity for Python 2.7 (Obsolete) node should be exported to git (see [Add Git Repository](#)) or updated first to use Execute Python Script node which uses Python 3. The script content will potentially need to be refactored to Python 3 (Python supplies a 2 to 3 tool for this if needed).
- Due to the dependency on the Python 2.7.x, the Ansible Tower adapter will also be deprecated in the next release.
 - Previous workflows using the noted Ansible Tower adapter should be exported to git (see [Add Git Repository](#)).
